Treatment Options for Periodontal and post-Traumatic patient in the Esthetic Area with Francesco Amato and Davide Mirabella

The topic of the lecture is the interdisciplinary approach for rehabilitation of the anterior maxillary area. Four different clinical scenarios in Periodontal or Post-Traumatic patient will be described:

- Clinical cases where the alveolar bone is compromised
- Clinical cases where both the alveolar bone and the soft tissue are compromised
- Clinical cases where the alveolar bone and the soft tissue are compromised and the teeth are missing
- Clinical cases where both the alveolar bone and the soft tissue are compromised in the interproximal papillary area

Different treatment options will be showed and detailed and pros and cons of each therapeutic line will be discussed. The lecture will focus on tissue response to orthodontic forced eruption; hard and soft tissue management both surgically and orthodontically or combining both treatment. Clinical experience and evidence based decision will be shared in order to give to the clinician practical guidelines to face the most challenging cases and achieve esthetic outcome with predictable and long term stable results.
